## Planned Building Works Disruption



The school will undergo an extensive heating system replacement over the summer holidays. We have been asked to vacate all classes on the top hall in preparation for this. In order to achieve this we have put the following plans in place:

- There will be no Rainbow Club for the last two weeks of school. We have asked Fit 4 Sport to change their times for these weeks to 2pm - 5pm so that working parents still have childcare options for this period.
- Year 6, Year 3 and Class 4D will start packing up their rooms and be rehoused to different locations when the contractors are ready to start.
- All clubs have been cancelled (this is also a covid measure to avoid cross class contact)

## Arrangements for next year...

This year children will again be able to watch a video introduction to their class teacher for next year. This will be uploaded to the school website shortly. Parents will receive a letter containing this information next week. Most year groups will be in 3 classes which means that some classes will be mixed in with others to form new class groups.
