Rainbow Club Update:

This week we have started up the Rainbow Club to target specific children who we have identified would benefit from some extra support. **This provision does not operate on a Friday but the Fit 4 Sport Club operates from 2pm.** I am hoping to extend this provision to Year 1 and Reception soon. We are just waiting for the pipework in these classes to be completed. The club is reviewed each half term to make sure we target all children in closing any gaps in their learning.

Year 4,5 and 6 Bagel Station

We are delighted to offer our year 4,5 and 6's the option of a grab and go bagel.

The small red gate will be opened at 7:35 every morning. The station will only be available until 8am.

Children who want a bagel need to line up along the wall and once the gates are open, they can enter the playground.

They will then be able to have a bagel, which they will eat underneath the sheltered area.

Once they have eaten the bagel, they will remain in this area until the rest of the school gates are open then go up to class as normal.
