This week...

This week Year 1 will be continuing to learn about some very exciting topics.

In Science we will be focusing on the seasons and what the weather is like in Winter, Spring, Autumn and Summer and how it changes. We will be discussing different types of weather and how it affects us!

In R.E. we will be thinking about what friendship means to Hindu people and how they can show friendship to one-another.

In History we will be looking at how America at the time of Rosa Parks and what is different now. It is an exciting week because the children will have the chance to rehearse a speech for Black History Month by recapping on what they have learnt about Rosa Parks.

In Art we will continue to explore the artist Van Gogh. We have drawn beautiful sunflower pictures which we will be painting with yellow, orange, green and brown colours. Ask your child if they can recall the colours of a sunflower.

Remember that this term our whole school focus will be on the word 'Respect'. How can we develop positive relationships by showing respect? Talk to your child at home about respect. How can it be shown and how do we receive it? What an exciting week we have ahead of us!

- **Read everyday for 10 minutes.** We will be giving out reading books and reading journals. We expect all children to have read everyday with a comment written in their books.
