## This weeks learning..

***This half term our topic is going to be focused on Human Rights.***

In Guided Reading we will be reading a new text called 'The Day You Begin' by Rafoel Lopez.

In R.E, we will begin to look at the different symbols used to represent the major religions. We will see why these symbols are important and what they look like across different religions.

In Art we will begin to look at creating our own portraits and this will lead on to our next lesson where we will create a portrait of our famous figure for this half term, Jesse Owens. We will be looking to sharpen our skills for drawing the correct oval head shape and using a mirror to draw our features.

In Maths we are going to be exploring subtraction using the counting back method and partitioning. How would I partition 336? Think: HTO's...
