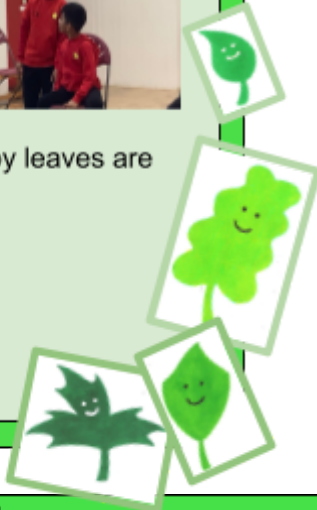
Year 4 Newsletter

This week's learning..

We have some great learning ahead of us. This week sees us continuing the English learning cycle and our topic based around Black History Month. The children have really enjoyed learning about Martin Luther King and seeing how human rights have changed over the years. They will continue to create their own speeches and will be rehearsing their performing skills ready to perform their speech to others. The children will participate in the second part of our Diverse Voices workshop to use drama to enhance their speech writing and oracy skills.

We are continuing our theme on freedom and safety this week. In Guided Reading we will begin a new book called The Journey. The children will be making predictions about the text and will use dictionaries to find the meaning of unknown words.

As mathematicians the children will begin a new topic on addition and subtraction within 10,000. In computing, the children will be looking at what makes a strong online community and they will create a pledge to adhere to shared norms for being in an online community.

As scientists the children will bring together their learning of electricity and work collaboratively to create an electrical zig zag game.

During R.S.H.E. the children are looking at how adults adds to the positive relationships within school and thinking about creating a thank you card to an unsung hero here at Star.

Spanish lessons continue for all children in year 4 and we have been so impressed with the amount of Spanish the children have remembered from Year 3.

Over to you...Home learning

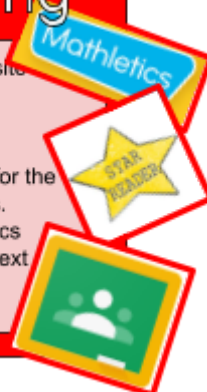
We have a spelling resource for the children to use at home. The website is www.oxfordowl.co.uk and Year 4 log on for all children is as follows:
