Our learning...





This term, we will start our new topic Media Mayhem.

English: We will be continuing our Read Write Inc phonics scheme where children will build their phonological knowledge and apply their writing skills to different genres of writing each week.

Maths: As Mathematicians will be learning about length. We will focus on different units of measurement such as cm and m.

Children will practise the practical skill of measuring different objects.

<u>Guided Reading:</u> Our new book is Toby and the Great Fire of London. With a close link to our History topic this term children will be able to practise their reading skills and apply this knowledge to lots of their learning.

<u>Science</u>: We will be diving into Material discussing their different properties and sharing our knowledge we already have. We will discuss how we can describe them: Are materials malleable, strong, smooth or transparent?

RE: This term we will be focusing on the question of 'Why did Jesus tell stories?' linking it to other religions and our own beliefs. This week will discuss what is a good story and start to read different stories told by Jesus.

<u>History:</u> As Historians we will be using our interactive Now Press Play to hook children into learning about The Great Fire of London.

P.E and Music will be scheduled for Tuesday afternoon each week as normal so remember to come dressed in your PE kit. Please continue to encourage your child to complete their tasks on our online learning platforms including Mathletics, Bug Club and Times Table Rockstars.

Don't forget!

Children will be given weekly Spellings to practise for 5 minutes each night. They will be tested on Friday and scores will be placed in their reading records. We politely ask children to also complete the 'Question of the Week' which needs to be handed in to their teachers on Friday.
