This weeks learning..

This week we will begin cycle 2 of our English lessons. This is all about non fiction texts and the children will be creating a published factfile both on paper and on their devices. We have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and this week the children will be looking at how some children were sent to the workhouse, why they were sent there and what life was like.

We are continuing our Maths - No Problem! scheme and this week the children will be looking time. They will learn to tell the time on a 24 hour clock, change minutes into seconds, hours into minutes and solve problems connected to the duration of time.

As scientists the children will be investigating melting and freezing. They will investigate the temperature chocolate, butter and cooking fat melts and how long it takes them to solidify.

In Geography this week the children will look at the Docklands and will be comparing what it was like in the past to what it is like now. The children will use Digimaps to help them with their investigations.

In R.S.H.E. we will be looking at cyberbullying and learning how to recognise it and how to deal with it.
