School starts at 7:50am each morning and finishes at 2pm each day.

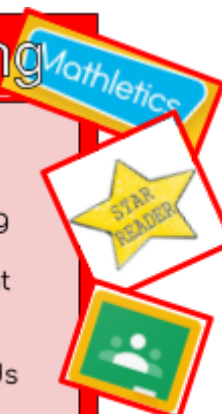
Don't forget to wear your school uniform.
