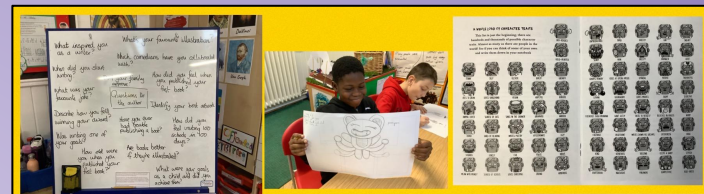


## Human Rights Day
