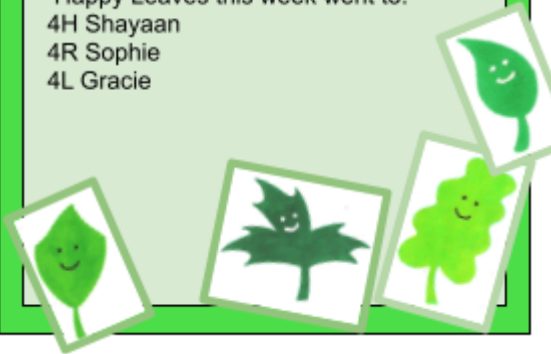
STAR moments
