Star Moments

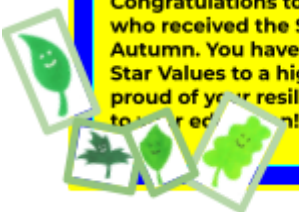
STAR OF THE TERM:
