This weeks learning..

This half term our topic is going to be focused on Earth our Home

In Guided Reading we will be looking at the Vanishing Rainforest. We will explore Roemama's journey into trying to find out why people are destroying her home in the rainforest.

In English we will be discovering what global warming and deforestation is and how human behaviour is impacting on our habitats. Be prepared to share your opinion and write a persuasive letter! What is persuasive writing?

In Maths we will be continuing to learn about Mass. We will be recapping our knowledge for the units we measure mass in and try to apply our knowledge in a variety of ways. From using measuring scales to working out word problems we have a lot to cover this week!

In Geography we will be finding out where our food comes from. During the week it would be great if you could look at the packaging of any food you are eating and see where it was produced.
