This half term we have the pleasure of exploring and delving into Space and Climate Change. We will be creating our very own fact files and embarking on debating global topics.

Our new science focus will be Earth and Space. As scientists, we will research the Earth we live on and the wonderful planets that surround it. We will also analyse the Sun and its relativivity in the solar system.
