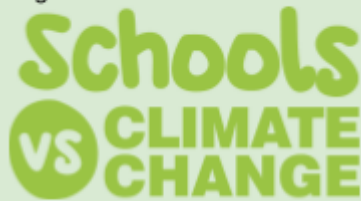

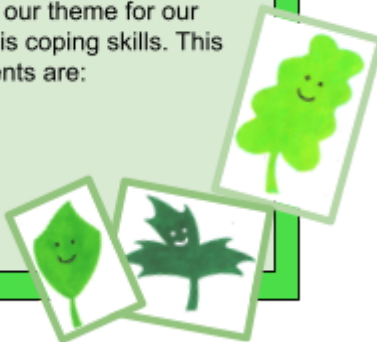
STAR moments

Another busy week in Year 4! The children have been so engaged in our topic this term. This week's learning:

As we continue with the very engaging topic Earth Our Home, the children will be writing a persuasive leaflet on an environmental subject of their choice, using persuasive language, expanded noun phrases and by the end of the week creating a polished piece to publish.

We will complete our work on multiplication and division where we will be looking at multiplying by 0 and 1, dividing by 1, multiplying the same 2 numbers and multiplying by three numbers. As scientists we will look at why there are so many different animals and plants living in one place, we will learn new vocabulary such as producer and detritivore. The children will begin to understand that so many different living things are able to survive because they all have different roles and different diets within their habitat.

In geography we find out what is it like to live in the Amazon and what is the quality of life like in the Amazon. We will also make comparisons to the children's own lives.

We will continue to learn about the Hindu faith and consider why a home shrine is important for a Hindu person. Children will be able to describe a number of different Hindu gods/goddesses explaining their symbols and why a Hindu person would look after them so carefully. Finally as artists we will be learning about the artist Andy Warhol and we will be creating rainforest animal drawings and paintings.
