During phonics, we will continue to learn new sounds and consolidate the ones we have already learnt, while in maths, we will be exploring the concept of addition.

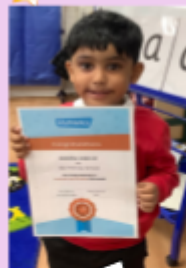


We will also look at celebrations around the world in preparation for Chinese New Year. We are continuing to learn that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

I won a certificate for my excellent work on Mathletics!

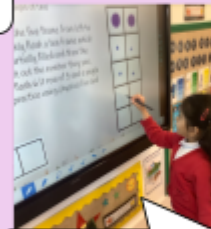


The ice is melting!
