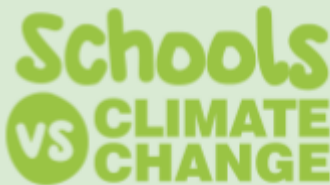

## This week's learning:

In English this week we will learning more on persuasive techniques and the children will learn how to participate in a debate and how to persuade others to see their point of view. The next couple of weeks may get a little heated! In maths we will continue looking at division and multiplication and the children will complete a mental maths and arithmetic tests.

During our foundation lessons in the afternoon we will continue R.E. looking at the Hindu religion and how Hindus worship at home. As scientists we will look at what micro habitats animals prefer and looking at these within larger habitats. In geography the children will continue their work on the Amazon and looking deeper into deforestation. We will also learn about how changes in the Amazon environment have affected the people who live there.
