If your child is in a sports club after school on a Monday, Wednesday or Thursday, they must come to school in their school uniform and bring a change of clothes with them.

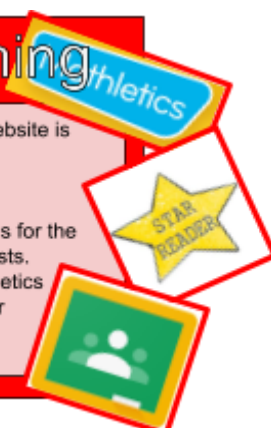
Over to you...Home learning
