This week's happy leaves go to:

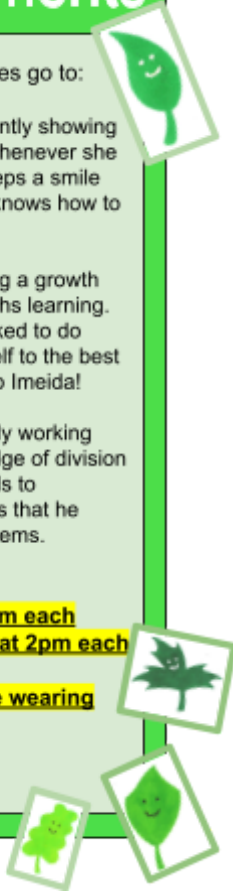
5T: Nathaly for consistently showing amazing coping skills. Whenever she struggles she always keeps a smile on her face and always knows how to ask for help.
