This week in year 2 we have lots of exciting lessons planned...

English: We will start the 2nd week of the writing cycle and will focus on planning our very own stories.

Maths: We will be continuing to develop our understanding of volume as well as learning how to respond to word problems involving volume. We will be reflecting on our challenge questions and what methods we can use to help us answer questions.

Science: We will be continuing our 'Animals including Humans' topic and will be learning about healthy eating and why it is important to eat food from every food group.

Art: This week, we will be learning about cubism and using paint to explore how a space can be filled and lines can be created using a variety of brush thicknesses.

Geography: We will be using maps of New Delhi and London to compare the different humans and physical features of each city.

P.E and Music will be scheduled for Tuesday afternoon each week as normal so remember to come dressed in your PE kit. Please continue to encourage your child to complete their tasks on our online learning platforms including Mathletics, Bug Club and Times Table Rockstars.
