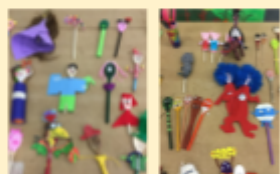
## This week's learning...

We will also be learning about Shrove Tuesday and what it represents. We may also get the opportunity to have our own pancakes to celebrate!

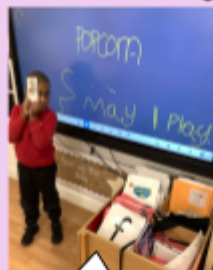


## STAR moments
