Our topic is...Express Yourself!

In RE, we will be exploring the Islamic faith and finding out why the Qur'an is important to muslims.

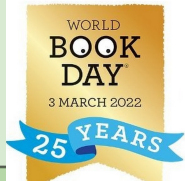
As scientists, we will be investigating which materials will form solutions and how to separate the substances from the solutions.

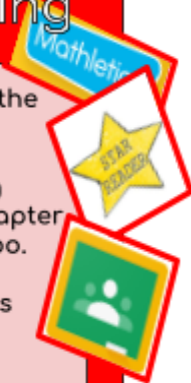
You still need to wear your Fit Friday kit on Friday.
