## This week's learning:

This week sees the start of our new topic called Global Treasures. We have lots of new learning to look forward to. In English, History and Shared Reading we will be exploring Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. In our English lessons the children will learn how to write a play script and in history we will create a timeline of Roman presence in Britain and looking at maps of the Roman Empire. In our Maths No Problem lessons the children will be continuing their second book and we will begin with learning about money. As scientists we will start a new topic all about animals including humans; we start the topic looking at the digestive system. The children will learn how to draw and label a diagram of the digestive system in humans. In R.E. this term we will gain an understanding about what happens when someone gets married, the children will be able to express their opinions and beliefs and compare them to what others believe. Our theme for Laughology this term is support and self confidence. The children will discover what support is and create their own support toolkit.

In P.E. the children will start with athletics and will be developing their skills in the art of running consistently and smoothly at different speeds. This will continue alongside music on a Tuesday morning where all children are expected in school in the correct P.E. kit.
