This week's learning:

We have an incredibly busy week this week! The children are so looking forward to our Festival of Voices rehearsal on Tuesday, the educational visit on Friday and the workshops happening in school on Thursday. We will continue with our Global Treasures topic this week and continue lots of new learning. In English, History and Shared Reading we will continue to read and learn about Julius Caesar and the Roman Empire. This week in our English lessons the children will be converting a story into their own play script and in history we will learn more of the Roman presence in Britain and looking at maps of the Roman Empire. In our Maths No Problem lessons the children will be continue their second book and we will learning more about money. As scientists the children will be building a 3D model of the human digestive system. They will use scientific words to name the parts of the digestive system and understand the order their appear in the body. In R.E. the children will begin to understand what vows are and the meaning behind vows or promises made in a wedding ceremony. Our theme for Laughology this term is support and self confidence, we will be learning how we can gain support from others, In P.E. the children will start with athletics and will be developing their skills in the art of running consistently and smoothly at different speeds.
