In Shared Reading plays are our focus and we will be reading the book Macbeth - An exciting book of betrayal and adventure, we will be looking at the themes of this story. We will be looking at the aftermath of Macbeth's decision and his descent into madness

-In English we will be continuing to delve into the world of Macbeth. This week we will be looking at the features of a playscript and begin to explore how to construct a scene using all of these features. We may even be able to act out some of our scenes!
