## This week's learning:

This short week will continue with our Global Treasures topic, please remember school is closed to children on Thursday (Polling Day).

This week in our English lessons the children will begin to plan their own play script where they will be describing their characters and setting ready to add to their scene. They will be using their skills from last weeks theatre group workshop to help them create their work. In our Maths No Problem lessons the children continue their work on money and learning to read word problems, picking out the important information and solving the questions asked. We are also busy learning our times tables to 12, practise these at home with your child and if you can, test them with a couple of quick questions each day. During our foundation lessons we will working on Design and Technology where the children will design a Roman chariot. In History we will build on our new knowledge from our visit to Colchester Castle and learn more about the Romans and in RE we will continue to learn about marriage and weddings within different religions. Our Spanish lessons continue where the children are learning about family members, how to pronounce words verbally and how to write simple sentences in Spanish.
