Our learning...

This week we will continue to prepare for our SATs tests which will take place from Monday 9th May until Thursday 12th May. We will focus on consolidating our knowledge and understanding of Reading, Maths and Spellings, Grammar and Punctuation (SPaG.)

Reading: As readers, we will focus on improving our reading stamina using our core shared reading texts: Romeo and Juliet as well as Mayan civilisations. We will practise answering 1, 2 and 3 mark questions using our reading skills: skimming, scanning, fluency, inferring and deducing.

SPaG: We will consolidate our knowledge and understanding of the spelling, grammar and punctuation strands of the English National Curriculum.
