As mathematicians, we will continue on adding and subtracting decimal numbers. We will then begin our new unit on percentages, where we will compare quantities and find percentages.

As writers we will now be beginning our second writing cycle on 'Non-chronological Reports'. The children will have the opportunity to look at a range of reports and gather data to write their own non-chronological report about Vikings.
