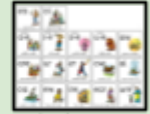

Year 1 Newsletter



This week...



Wow! The weather has been great lately! We hope you have been enjoying some lovely family time in the sun. There has been lots of excitement in the classroom lately as the children's broad bean seeds have begun to sprout. Keep practising those phonics sounds at home with your child as it is not long until the Year 1 Phonic Screening test!

It is statutory that your child comes to school everyday. Keep up the great progress Year 1!

Our learning this week:

In Maths, we will be focusing on counting to 100. Practise this at home. If you write down a 2 digit number, can your child identify it? What if one more/less than that number?

In Science, we will be looking at the differences between evergreen and deciduous trees. With your child, have a look at the trees around you. Do you know the names of any trees? Compare the different leaves. Can you describe them?

In R.E., as theologians, we will continue to explore belonging and learn about the differences between a Dedication and a Baptism.

In History, we will continue learning about old toys! We will be looking at how computers have changed toys and how they have developed over time.

In DT, as engineers, we will be making a lever toy and demonstrating how it works.

In RSHE, we will be thinking about how we can build a good support system. Who helps us? Who can I turn to if I need support?
