## Our learning...

Now that our SATs tests are over, we will spend the next two weeks diving into our Global Treasures topic for some really exciting learning!

**Shared Reading:** We will complete our reading of Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet. We will explore the themes of love, fate, death, honour and friendship and how they affect the characters and influence the story.

**English:** We will explore playscripts and identify their key features. We will use the famous balcony scene of Romeo and Juliet to write a scene for our playscripts. We will then rehearse and perform our scenes in groups.

**Science (3 lessons):** We will be investigating how electricity flows through a circuit and how the conductors enable the flow of electrons. We will also be drawing circuit diagrams using standard symbols and be able to give reasons for why the brightness of a bulb changes and investigate how the brightness of a bulb is related to the voltage of a cell.

**History (3 lessons):** We will introduce our new topic of the Mayans and start conducting our own research on who they were. We will then use this research to plot key events on a timeline. We will also be looking at how we know the Mayans existed.

**DT :** We will use our tapestry designs from last week and the looms that we created to start to weave our own tapestries.

**RSHE: Support focus -** We will be finding out how we can give and gain support. **Sexual harassment focus:** We will be identifying the importance of maintaining safe and healthy relationships and recognise the role of gender in sexual harassment. We will also learn how to respond to behaviour relating to sexual harassment.
