This weeks learning..

In Shared Reading we have a new text this week and we will be focusing on using our analysing skills. We will be focusing on a non-fiction text all about the Stone Age. We will look into reading through the text and we will be using our retrieval skills to identify key facts as well as ambitious and interesting vocabulary.

-In English we will be starting Cycle 2 of our Star Writing focusing on creating a fact filled brochure for the Stone Age! This week we will be finalising our non-chronological report. We will spend the week reviewing our skills before using them for in our final hot write.

-In Maths we will be finding a fraction of a number and sharing one and more than one.

-In Science we will be reaching the end our Rocks unit. Our focus will be on reflecting on the different stages of our learning journey and recording the new knowledge learnt at each stage .
