This week's learning...



On Monday, Year 5 will be visiting Eastlea Community School for a Themed Transition Day. to take part in a range of PE, Science and Art activities. We will be returning back to Star at **3:00pm**.

On Tuesday, Year 5 will be taking part in KS2 Sports Day where they will participate in a range of PE activities including hurdles, target throwing, shot put, javelin and running races. **Please ensure your child wears sunscreen that morning, is dressed in the their PE kit and brings in a bottle of water.**

In Maths, we will be revising content that we have learnt since september and revisiting key concepts. This is because we will be completing our final Maths assessments.

In RSHE, the children will be exploring the effects of peer pressure and ways in which they can deal with this.
