This weeks learning..

In Shared Reading we will be exploring Jim's dreams and how he uses the lion to help him.

In English we will be exploring the different features of Instructional texts. We will also be creating toolkits to help us structure our writing. Towards the end of the week, we will be following instructions to create our own healthy snacks.

In Maths, this week we will complete our end of term assessments and will begin to explore parallel and perpendicular lines.

In Geography, we will be looking at how to use a compass to navigate the cardinal directions. We will be using our compasses to explore our local environment and practise using them.

In Art, we are using clay to make a 3D real life model of a sandwich inspired by the artist Claes Oldenburg.
