This week's learning...



In reading, Year 5 will continue reading the story 'Broccoli Boy' and discovering how a world pandemic is stopped by a single child!

As writers, the children will write their very own meditation story using ambitious vocabulary, imperative verbs and writing devices that the author discussed with them last week.

As mathematicians, the children will have the opportunity to learn all about the volume; the children will learn that volume measures the amount of space taken by an object in three dimensions.
