## Year Six Awards Ceremony



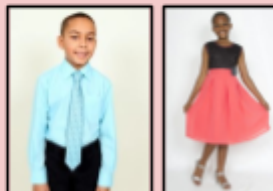
Save the date - Wednesday 13th July 6pm - 7:30pm
