Our Learning

This term our school theme is **HUMAN RIGHTS.** This week in year 1 we have lots of exciting lessons olarmed...

English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday,

Maths:

As a mathematicians, we will be recapping counting to 10 and extending our learning by ordering numbers matching quantity to numerals.

<u>RSHE</u>

In RSHE this term we will be looking at positive relationships. This week we will be discussing and understanding 'How can I make others belong and be a good friend?'

<u>RE</u>
