

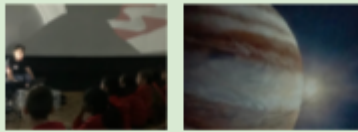

This week's learning..

We have another very busy week of learning ahead! We will continue with our Rights theme this half term which is Freedom and Safety.

In Shared Reading we will continue to read *Azzi In Between*, the children will be exploring the characters in the book and answering questions about what they have read. In English we continue reading the book *The Arrival* where the children will be creating their own stories using this story as inspiration.

As mathematicians the children will be learning how to order numbers to 10000 and look for patterns in numbers. In computing, we will be learning how a strong password can help protect our privacy. This lesson will help children to create a password that is secure and memorable.

As scientists the children will measure the temperature at which solids melt. We will introduce the concept of melting point, investigate the melting point of different materials - chocolate, butter, metal and cheese and use a water baths with different temperatures for each group of children.

As historians we will be learning about the Civil rights Movement and creating a chronological timeline.

We are noticing some very aspiring artists in year 4 and this week we will continue learning about the artist Pablo Picasso. The children will be creating their own portraits inspired by his work.

In R.E. we will be learning about who and what influenced Pandurang. We will make connections between religious teachings and the lives of followers. During R.S.H.E. the children are looking at the positive relationships and how they can form positive relationships when they are not sure what the other person or activity needs.

P.E. this term sees the children working on their gymnastics skills and how to play competitive games. Finally in music the children will continue with their Rockin' Recorders work. Ask your child to show you the dance their are learning as part of our Fit Friday sessions this term.

Don't forget!

P.E is on Wednesday - Children need to wear their PE kit to school. Remember to bring in a jumper as the days begin to get a little colder.

Over to you...Home learning

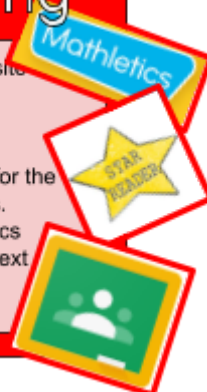
We have a spelling resource for the children to use at home. The website is www.oxfordowl.co.uk and Year 4 log on for all children is as follows:
