## Our Learning

#### This week:

#### English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday.

#### Maths:

As a mathematicians, pupils will learn different ways of making numbers using number bond diagrams. They will use their understanding of number bonds to create number stories using pictorial representations.

#### Computing

We will continue working with our Chromebooks and practice identifying and typing our usernames and passwords to build up our logging in skills. At home discuss the different types of technology you use and where and when you would use a password.
