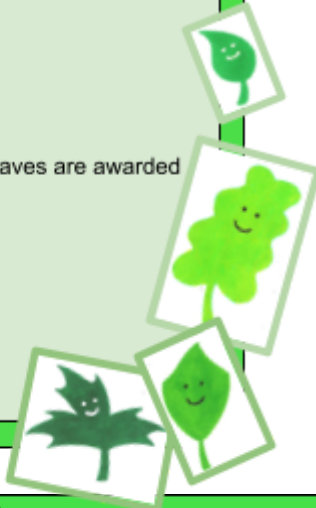
STAR moments

This week's learning..

We have another very busy week of learning ahead!

We are continuing our theme on freedom and safety this week. In Shared Reading we will continue to read *Azzi In Between*, the children will be reading for a purpose and using their comprehension skills to answer questions about the text. As writers this week we will begin to learn how to write a speech. We will use Dr. Martin Luther King's 'I Have a Dream' speech as inspiration. The children will learn about the features of a speech and what is needed to create a powerful one that makes people sit up and think.

As scientists we will observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled? (evaporation and condensation). As Historians we will begin to offer our opinion on the views of MLK and Malcolm X. As part of our Black history month celebration as artist we will study the artist Kara Walker who created silhouette artwork, we will use her work as inspiration to create our own artwork using her methods.

In R.E. this week the children will explain how religious beliefs can be shown through special objects. We will be comparing and contrasting different objects and religions. We continue our work on positive relationships in R.S.H.E. lessons where we will answer the question, 'What is my role in creating positive relationships in school?'

Finally in our computing lessons we will use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content.

P.E. this term sees the children working on their gymnastics skills and how to play competitive games.

Finally in music the children will continue with their Rockin' Recorders work.

Over to you...Home learning

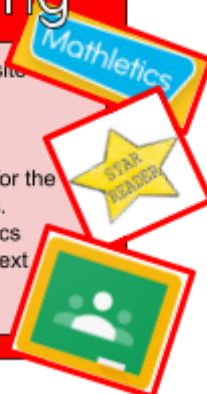
We have a spelling resource for the children to use at home. The website www.oxfordowl.co.uk and Year 4 log on for all children is as follows:
