This week's learning:



Reading: We will use our comprehension skills to learn more about the life of Frederick Douglass.

English: We will be continuing to develop our narrative focused on the arrest of Emmeline Pankhurst. We will then edit our writing, and use our upleveled work to write a creative narrative using all the descriptive devices we have learnt throughout the last two weeks!

Maths: Continuing with using the four operations, this week our focus will be on multiplying 4-digit numbers by a 2-digit number then moving onto the inverse - division with up to 4-digit numbers.
