Year 1 Newsletter

Our Learning

This week:

English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday. We will also be continuing to explore a new book about Rosa Park as part of our Shared Reading.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we will learn that subtraction equations can be completed in three ways: by crossing out, by using number bonds and by counting back. They will continue to use manipulatives and pictorial representations to support their understanding and use vocabulary appropriately.

Computing:

We will continue working with our Chromebooks and practice identifying and typing our usernames and passwords to build up our logging in skills. At home, discuss who your child can speak to if they see something online that makes them feel worried or upset.

RE:

As theologians, we will be talking about how a friendship band can be important to a Hindu person and what happens at Raksha Bandhan. At home, can you make a special friendship band for a brother, sister or someone special, using craft materials.

Art

This week in Art children will be creating artwork with charcoal in the style of Jacob Lawrence. Have a look at some of Lawrence's artwork with your child online to help inspire your child's creativity.

Science:

As scientists, we will be exploring weather changes and talking about the different clothes we need to wear for each type of weather. Children will also be looking outside to identify what changes they notice in the environment e.g. the changes in the trees and the temperature.

Historu:

As historians, we will be talking why Rosa Parks is an important historical figure? Why was it such an 'event' that Rosa Parks sat down on a bus?

P.E and Music is scheduled for Monday afternoon. So, remember to come dressed in your correct PE kit. If you are unsure, check the uniform policy on Star's newly designed website or ask your teacher.

- Read everyday for 10 minutes. We will be giving out three reading books; an Oxford book, a
