Our Learning

This week:

English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books, Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday.

We have an exciting speech competition coming up linked to our shared reading book Rosa Parks and the work we have been doing in history. This week the children will get to record their class speech using green screen technology.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we'll be looking at positional and directional language. At home, practise using this vocabulary at home: front, middle, top, between, next to, second from the left etc.

Computina:

This week the children will be asked to generate rules which will help them to use technology more responsibly. We will also continue to practise logging in to the chromebooks using our usernames and passwords.

RE:

As theologians, we will show and compare special things that happen in different families. Talk to your child about different celebrations you may have at home or anything you do together. Do you wear special clothing or eat special food? Do you go on holiday together or watch a movie? We will be asking children to send in a photo or something special you do in your family.

Science:
