This week's learning..

Our final week of the term, we cannot believe how quickly it has crept up on us! We have some great learning ahead of us. This week sees us completing the English learning cycle and our topic based around Black History Month. The children will use the oracy skills they have learnt in our English lessons to help them perform their speeches written last week.

We are continuing our theme on freedom and safety this week. In Shared Reading we will look at the book called The Journey. The children will be answering questions about the book and identifying similar themes in different texts.

As mathematicians the children will begin a new topic on addition and subtraction within 10,000. In computing, the children will look at 'Who owns the web?' We will explore who owns the content on the World Wide Web (or 'web' for short). They will explore a variety of websites and will investigate what they can and cannot do with the content on them. They will also relate this to principles of ownership and sharing in the real world.

As scientists children will investigate how temperature affects the speed of evaporation. We will answer questions such as does a puddle last for longer in the Winter or the Summer? Children will set up an investigation to examine the effect of temperature on evaporation.

Spanish lessons continue for all children in year 4 and we have been learning the days of the week and the months of the year.

As Historians we will discuss the reason for the assassination of Martin Luther King and this will lead the children into being able to explain who Martin Luther King was and what his dream was.

Over to you...Home learning

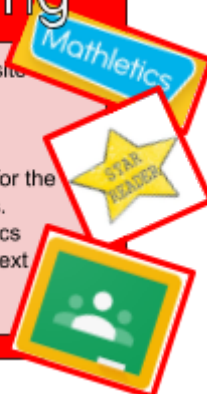
We have a spelling resource for the children to use at home. The website is www.oxfordowl.co.uk and Year 4 log on for all children is as follows:
