## This week's learning..

Can you believe it's October already! We have some great learning ahead of us. This week sees 2nd week of our English learning cycle. We continue our new topic based around Black History Month. In year 4 we will be looking into the life of Martin Luther King and seeing how human rights have changed over the years. The children will be creating their own speeches around human rights and some will performing theirs to others in school. We have been very lucky to be part of a workshop with Miss Roy who has inspired us to use drama to enhance our speech writing and oracy skills

We are continuing our theme on freedom and safety this week. In Guided Reading we will continue to read *Azzi In Between*, the children will be making inferences about the text they are reading and using their comprehension skills to answer questions.

As mathematicians the children will continue working on rounding 4 digit numbers to the nearest ten or hundred. In computing the children will outline how information can be shared via the World Wide Web (WWW), explain the types of media that can be shared on the WWW, I can describe where websites are stored when uploaded to the WWW and describe how to access websites on the WWW.

As scientists we will identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle, by the end of the lesson children should be able to clearly explain the meaning of evaporation and condensation and identify situations where this happens.

During R.S.H.E. the children are looking at the positive relationships and looking at what is their role in creating positive relationships in school. The children will be creating posters to share with the younger children in school.

Spanish lessons continue this week for all children in year 4 so on that note, adiós y que tengas una buena semana.

## Over to you...Home learning

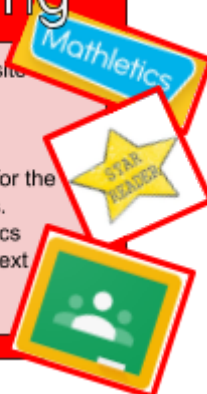
