This week:

English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday. We will be reading a book in class called 'Wee and the Wright Brothers', which is about some of the first airplanes.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we'll be looking at numbers to 20. At home practice counting to twenty. You can use cubes or pasta or anything that can be counted to get to 20!

This week the children will be looking at how to behave sensibly online, in a way that does not upset others. We will learn how negative comments can upset others.

As theologians, we will be looking at what makes a good gift. We will discuss the different gifts we give to different people and we will compare this to the Nativity story where gifts were brought to baby Jesus.

As scientists, we will be investigating further the properties of different materials by looking at different objects and grouping them according to their properties, e.g. flexible, rigid, hard, soft History:

As historians, we will be creating a timeline of planes to learn when different types of planes came into existence e.g. The first ever plane was made in 1903 and then the Spitfire in 1936.
