Of course I am also very happy with the children as always. Today we have had a moment to reflect on the devastating effects of war and held a minute's silence to mark **Remembrance Day**.

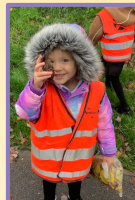
