Our Learning

This week:

English:

As a writer, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

We will be reading a book in class called 'Wee and the Wright Brothers', which is about some of the first airplanes.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we'll be looking at adding numbers to 20. Find out, from your child, what method would the best to solve an addition equation!

Computing:

This week the children will be introduced to the idea of podcast. We will listen to to podcasts and discuss them.
