In our English lessons we are continuing our newspaper work. The children will learn how to be editors and edit their article ready to publish in the class newspaper on Friday.

We will continue with the Maths - No Problem! scheme and this week the children will be moving on to work on multiplication.

In science, the children will continue the topic of sound and they will be learning how to explain the difference between pitch and volume.

In Shared Reading, we will be continuing to work on comprehension skills and we will be teaching the children how to quote directly from the book they are reading to answer questions.
