Our Learning

This week

English:

As a writer, we will be continving our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books.

Children will be learning new sounds and we will practice reading and writing everyday.

We will be reading a book called, Little People, Big Dreams: Amelia Earhart. This is about a woman, Amelia Earhart, who was the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic ocean.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we'll be looking at subtracting numbers to 20. Find out, from your child, what method would be the best to solve a subtraction equation!

Computing:

This week the children will be using the Sketches Schools app to draw a picture of one of the Wright brothers. They will then upload their work to another app called ChatterPix to create a podcast. This will be linked to the lives of Orville and Wilbur Wright.

RE:

As theologians, we will learning about why the Christmas story is important to Christians. We will also be finding out about what happens for a Christian at Christmas. Can you see any signs around outside that shows you Christmas might be arriving soon.

Science:

As scientists, we will be taking part in an exciting workshop called Sublime Science Workshop. This is linked to our Materials topic and will be very fun and exciting. Remember, we are asking you to create a boat at home with your child and bring it in to school the Week beginning Monday 28th November. Will your boat float or sink?

As historians, we will be learning about how aeroplanes have changed over the years. We will be thinking about things like: How is the Wright Flyer different from a modern aeroplane?

We will also be beginning to practise our Year 1 performance. We are very excited! Your children may receive a script to take home to help them learn their lines.
