This week all Year 4 children will be visiting the Museum of London (Docklands). This visit will bring to life some of the learning that has happened in our English and History lessons. The children will be provided with a packed lunch and return to school at 2.00pm.

We will begin cycle 2 of our English lessons. This is all about non fiction texts and the children will be creating a published factfile both on paper and on their devices. We have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and this week the children will be looking at how some children were sent to the workhouse, why they were sent there and what life was like.
