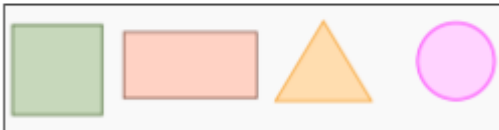

### THIS WEEK'S LEARNING

This week in Phonics, we will continue to learn new sounds and consolidate the ones we have already learnt. We will also be using Fred Talk to practise our blending skills.

During maths, our new topic is 2D shapes! We will compare squares and rectangles and identify triangles. Children will use informal language to describe similarities, differences and parts of 2D shapes e.g. number of sides and number of corners.
